I am considering a launch of a crowdfunding operation, as I am in a disastrous professional situation making the launch of my business very difficult due to a harassment situation by my employer, from which I could not get any response from our judicial system.

As you can see from the whole site, which I designed and developed on my own, I do have some skills allowing me to create a business model, and my work until now involves an activist engagement for free education.

My problem is that my situation following years of harassment makes it difficult both to ask support from regular banking and from government supporting agencies for innovative business.

I have a social media audience from which I am confident that they would provide support, because they saw or benefitted from my engagement in free education.

I am considering a limited crowdfunding operation, capped to 50 000 euros.

Do you think that such an operation could be considered compliant with paypal's Croudfunding guidelines?
